[Driving Course (3 hours)]



Iron Plate Road

A road formerly lined with corrugated iron plates that was built to deliver artillery shells over the sand to the test firing range that was contructed on Uchinada's coast. (MAP 1)



US Military Balistics Command Post Remains

This building was used as the command center for the US military's test firing range that once opperated in Uchinada. It still stands in it's original form. (MAP 2)



Sunset Bridge Uchinada

This 344 meter long cable-staved bridge resembles a swap with its graceful appearance and is an Uchinada landmark. (MAP 3)



Monument

This monument commemorates Yasushi Inque who visited Uchinada's dunes and published literary works such as "Meteor" and "Sea". (MAP 4)

Uchinada Town General Park Observatory

The 60 meter high circular observation platform offers a 360°view of the entire town and the surrounding sea and lagoon. (MAP **9**)



Kahoku Lagoon

Check out the Yume Milk Kan dairy. redwood trees, and sunflower maze in the farmlands next to the Kahoku-Lagoon. (MAP 10)










Great Views Around Uchinada!



Sunset Bridge Uchinada

Sunset Bridge Uchinada, a town symbol, is a graceful 344 meter long cable-stayed bridge that is lit up from sunset to 9 p.m. (9:30 p.m. from April to September). When lit up it envelopes the surrounding area in a romantic atmosphere.



Uchinada Coast

The Uchinada coast boasts a 200 meter long stretch of sandy beach and bustles with marine sports and beach goers alike. It is one of Japan's 3 largest sand-duned beaches, and was designated as one of Japan's top 100 hundred beaches by the Ministry of the Environment.



Lovers' Sanctuary

The area surrounding the Uchinada Beach and Sunset Bridge Uchinada has been designated as a Lovers' Sanctuary. Couples often visit the bell tower here to enjoy the 360° view, and ring the "Bell of Happiness".

Dune Literature

Uchinada's sea and dunes inspired many literary figures

Many literary figures fell in love with the history and climate unique to Uchinada's dunes and depicted them in their work. Common themes deal with the 10 years following the end of World War II during the Uchinada Struggle and depict protagonists grappling with their way of life in those chaotic times. If it were not for the long history of Uchinada villagers' fighting against the wind and harsh climate, this kind of literature may have never been written.

This is a shrine with a long history, it bears the family crest of the Maeda family of the Kaga domain. The main shrine was built by the Kaga clan in 1828 and moved to the present location in 1889.



Awagasaki Amusement Park Hokuriku's Takarazuka

Awagasaki Amusement Park opened in 1925 nestled amongst Uchinada's dunes. This expensive property was built on roughly 50 achres and included a large theater, lodging, amusement park, baseball field, and a ski slope to entertain park quests. The performances by the resident all girls theater troupe were immensely popular, especially among the younger generation, and the park became known as the "Takarazuka of Hokuriku". Awagasaki Amusement Park was swept away by the war and the times, and literally crumbled like a house of cards, leaving no trace. However, a singular artifact remains, a part of the arch of the old main building survives to this day.










Uchinada Struggle Japan's First Anti-Base Struggle

In 1952, after World War II, the government took over the Uchinada dunes as an artillery test range for U.S. forces in Japan, which led to the Uchinada Struggle, the first nationwide anti-base struggle. The fierce opposition, waged under the slogan "Money is for one year, land is for ten thousand years," came to an end with the complete withdrawal of U.S. forces in 1957.



A big event where kites from all over the world gather on the Uchinada dunes! Every year, kite enthusiasts from Japan and abroad challenge each other with their Japanese and Western kites. The World Kite Festival is held in May every year.

covering an area of 4.20 km, and spans Uchinada Town, Kanazawa City, Tsubata Town, and Kahoku City. Many migratory birds such as swans and geese flying in from Siberia can be seen here, making it a treasure trove of wild birds and a popular place for bird watching.



US Military Balistics Command Post Remains

The firing command center at the U.S. military test firing range, which was the starting point of the Uchinada Struggle, still stands quietly next to Uchinada Beach. The two-story concrete building still retains its original shape after more than 60 years.





Spa

The perfect spot to warm up and relax while enjoying the spectacular view of Uchinada!

The baths are in an excellent location with a view of the Hakusan and Tateyama mountain ranges in the distance and the Kahokugata spreading out at your feet. The coffee-colored water is a mild chloride spring that will warm you up from the core. (Bathing fee: 500 yen for adults, 200 yen for elementary school students, and free for children under elementary school age)

Uchinada Hamanasu Dinosaur Park

This popular park is home to a 6 meter tall dinosaur statue. There is also a dinosaur themed play structure, zipline, swings, athletic field, and a sandbox.



Sunflower Maze (Kahoku Lagoon Farmlands)

Every year from late July to early August, 350,000 sunflowers bloom on this 6 acher farm. The 1km long maze and the observation deck are popular attractions.



Cherry Blossom Driveway

1,500 cherry trees planted in two rows along the 4.5 km bank of the Kahoku Lagoon make this road one of the most popular cherry blossom viewing spots in the prefecture.

Uchinada Mochi was born several years ago when Uchinada was looking to create local specialties. These rice cakes are a recreation of the peanut mochi Mr. Kawabe remembers eating as a young boy. The slightly sweet peanuts and soft rice cake make for a delicious combination. He makes the rice and peanuts used in the mochi with his son which gives Uchinada Mochi a distinctive handmade taste that can only be found
